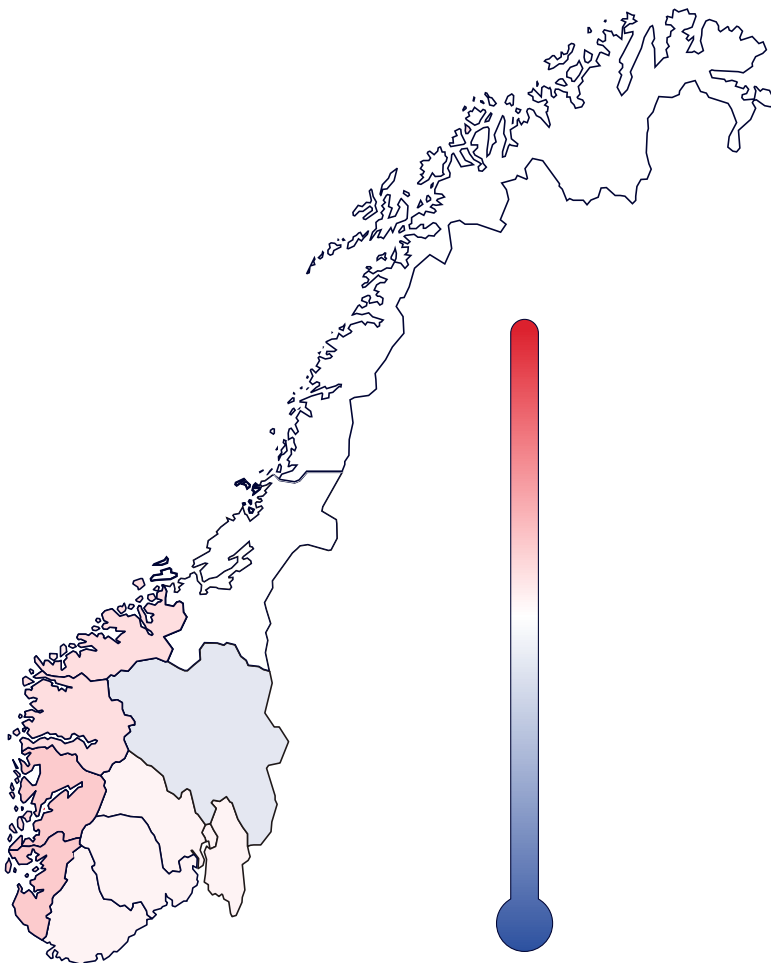

National report



Increased exports support growth, but construction activity continues to decline

Regional Network contacts expect activity to rise through winter, but developments across industries still vary widely. Contacts report that strong competitiveness is boosting the export of domestically produced goods and services. In addition, higher petroleum and defence industry demand is boosting growth. On the other hand, declining construction activity and weak growth in household demand are weighing on activity growth. Capacity utilisation is little changed from the previous survey, and there are approximately as many contacts reporting labour shortages. Contacts are planning for approximately the same investment levels in 2025, and have revised up their estimate for wage growth in 2025 from 4.3% in the previous survey to 4.5% in this survey.

Contacts expect activity growth to rise slightly through winter

Contacts expect activity to increase further in 2024 Q4 and 2025 Q1 (Chart 1). Activity growth expectations in 2024 Q4 are little changed since the previous survey (Chart 2). At the same time, contacts expect activity growth to pick up slightly in 2025 Q1. There are wide differences across industries. Oil service contacts expect high growth through winter, however, construction and retail trade contacts expect activity to decline. Manufacturing contacts expect a rise in exports to boost growth, while corporate demand in particular is improving prospects in services.

Expected growth current quarter and next quarter. Seasonally adjusted. Percent

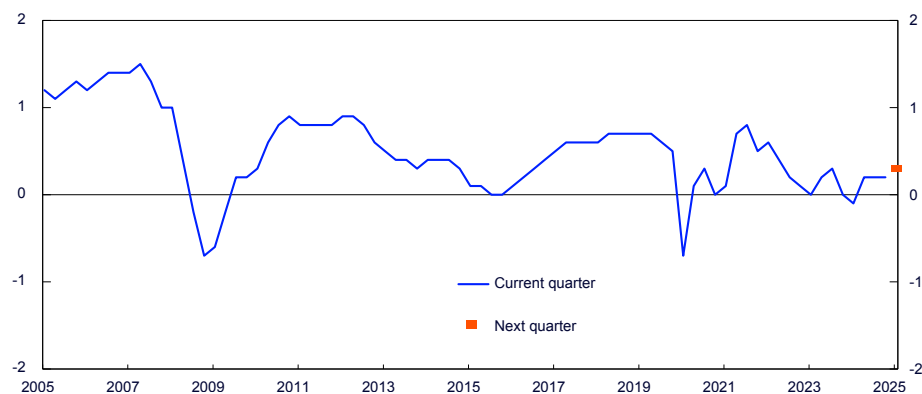
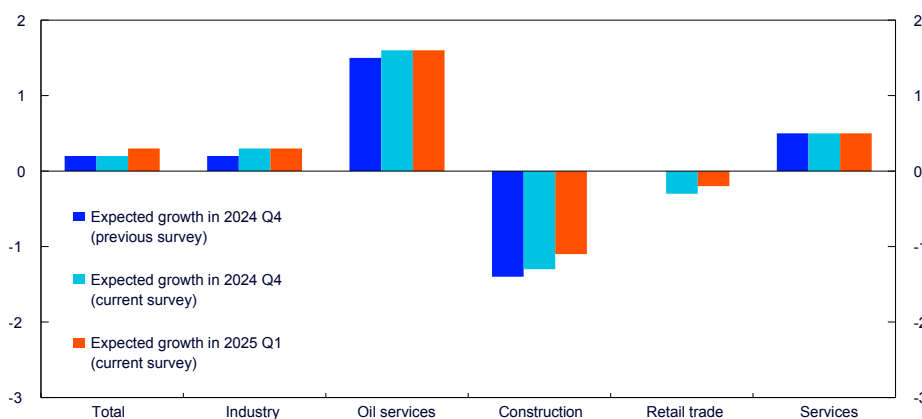


Chart 2 Output growth. All sectors

Continued decline in construction

Prospects remain the weakest in construction, and contacts expect activity to continue to decline through winter. Contacts report that high financing and construction costs continue to dampen new residential and commercial construction, and a number of contacts report that very few new projects have been launched. Some contacts in residential property development report that new home sales have edged up, particularly in the western regions of Norway, but the majority of contacts nevertheless expect that housing starts will remain low through winter. Moreover, contacts report a decline in the construction of commercial buildings such as offices, hotels and shopping centres. In addition, a number of contacts highlight fewer local government construction contracts. On the other hand, large public construction projects boost growth among some contacts. Activity is also rising among some enterprises in technical fields, particularly those working on oil industry projects.

Rise in exports

The rise in output among manufacturing enterprises is largely driven by higher sales volumes in export markets. Many of the enterprises report that competitiveness is sound, and a number of enterprises report increased market shares. At the same time, some enterprises report increased uncertainty owing to prospects of higher trade barriers. As in previous surveys, manufacturers of defence material report the sharpest rise in growth. In addition, a number of enterprises report substantial growth owing to the energy transition. For example, contracts for ships and platforms for offshore wind projects contribute to growth in shipbuilding. On the other hand, contacts in fisheries report that lower quotas are resulting in reduced deep sea fishing volumes and that production problems in aquaculture are leading to lower volumes. Among manufacturing contacts, building materials manufacturers report the most pronounced decline in growth and expect the production of building materials to fall further towards spring.

Oil service contacts expect strong growth this winter and that export-oriented activity will increase most. Oil service contacts report that competitiveness has improved, alongside a growing willingness to invest in the global oil and gas industry. In the domestic market, the petroleum tax package has contributed to solid growth in recent years. Even though many oil service contacts now operate at a high level as a result, they expect activity to increase in the beginning of 2025. Some contacts report that the projects they are working on have been expanded, making them larger than previously assumed.

Higher business sector demand

In commercial services, contacts involved in cloud platforms, information security and artificial intelligence in particular reported strong growth. Contacts also reported that stricter climate reporting requirements are resulting in higher order levels for auditors and consultants. Demand for legal assistance is rising, and a number of contacts point to an increase in the number of disputes and bankruptcies. Contacts also report a rise in the number of purchased and sold businesses and commercial properties, which is generating higher order levels for lawyers, consultants and brokers. Furthermore, a number of enterprises report rising demand for communication and advertisement services. Both architects and recruitment agencies expect that the decline in construction will dampen activity ahead and enterprises expect the decline to also dampen growth in areas such as technical consulting, goods transport and waste management.

Weaker growth in household demand

Retail trade contacts expect turnover volume to fall through winter, while service contacts expect lower growth in household demand. The decline in sales is most pronounced for capital goods such as cars, furniture and building materials, while sales of consumer goods are increasing somewhat. Among service contacts such as hotels and restaurants, the

number of private customers continues to rise. The rise in foreign guests accounts for the sharpest increase. At the same time, many contacts point out that per customer sales are lower than earlier in 2024. In both retail trade and services, many contacts report that households have become more cautious, with a number of contacts citing policy rate expectations. On the other hand, many contacts point out that lower inflation improves household purchasing power and envision higher demand towards spring.

Minor changes in investment in 2025

Contacts expect slightly lower investment in 2024 than in 2023 and that investment will remain at approximately the same level in 2025. In manufacturing, a number of enterprises are nearing the completion of large energy transition and automation projects. Even though these investments are already at a high level, contacts are planning for further growth in 2025. Among service contacts, investment is being dampened in 2024 by the low number of new CRE projects. In this survey, there are signals that certain deferred projects will commence in 2025, and service contacts overall expect a slight increase in investment in 2025. In oil services, capacity expansion investment has been substantial in recent years. Many of these projects are near completion and oil service contacts are planning for lower investment in 2025. Lower sales and weakened profitability in retail trade have led to lower investment in 2024, and enterprises are planning for further reductions in investment in 2025. Investment is being dampened in particular by prospects for lower investment in grocery trade, where substantial investment has already been made in recent years.

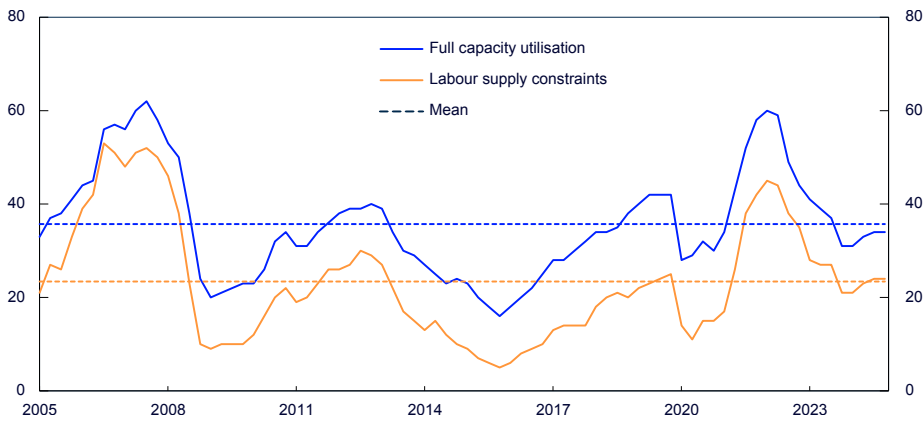
Unchanged capacity utilisation

Contacts are planning for an increase in employment in both 2024 Q4 and 2025 Q1. As in the previous surveys, contacts in oil services and services are planning for the strongest growth, but manufacturing contacts are also planning to increase workforces. Contacts cite higher expected order levels as the primary reason for the increase, and some contacts cite the need for new expertise. At the same time, automation has enabled a number of enterprises to reduce their workforces over time. Contacts in construction and retail trade are planning for reduced employment ahead. In construction, falling order levels are the primary reason for the lower demand for labour, but a number of enterprises report that they are attempting to retain their labour and instead reduce the use of contractors. With lower sales volumes and weaker profitability, more retail trade enterprises will reduce employment.

Since the previous survey, the share of contacts reporting full capacity utilisation has remained unchanged (Charts 3 and 4). The share of contacts reporting recruitment difficulties is also unchanged since the previous survey. There is a particular shortage of engineers and skilled workers, and strong competition for such expertise across sectors.

Chart 3 Capacity utilisation¹ and labour supply constraints²

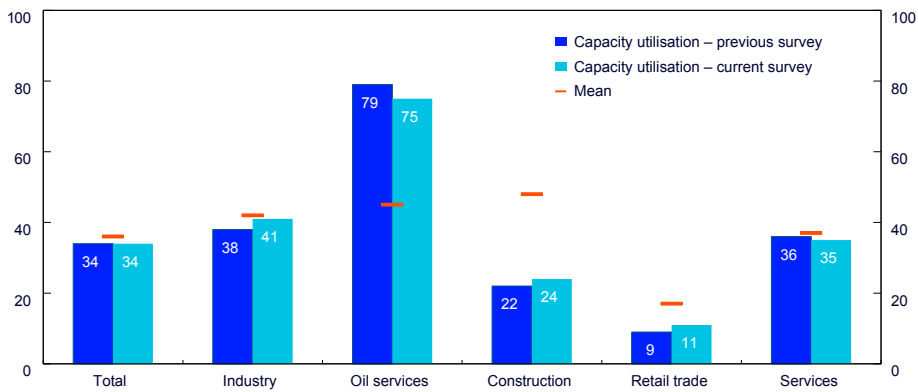

Figur 4 Capacity utilisation¹

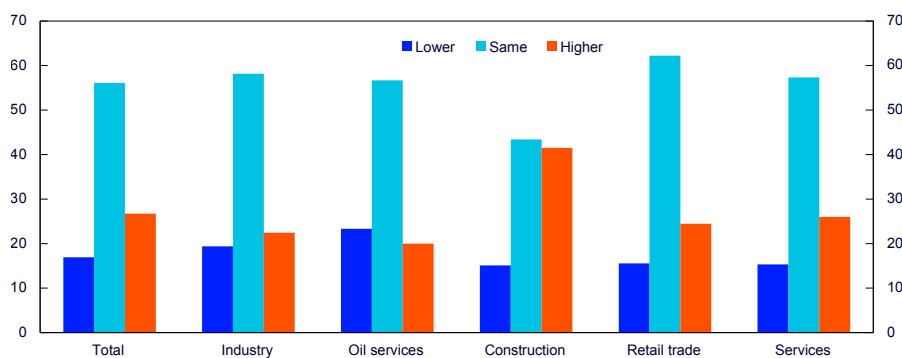

As in the previous survey, contacts were asked by how much they could reduce their workforces while maintaining current output levels. On average, contacts responded that workforces could be reduced by between 4% and 5%, and a majority of contacts responded that this share level was normal (Chart 5). At the same time, there were more contacts reporting this workforce share as somewhat higher than normal than the number of contacts reporting the opposite. The share was particularly high among construction contacts. The results are in line with responses from the previous survey.

Annual wage growth projections revised up for 2025

Contacts expect annual wage growth to be 5.2% in 2024, as in the survey from 2024 Q3. However, annual wage growth projections for 2025 have been revised up from 4.3% to 4.5% in this survey (Chart 6). Wage growth projections for 2025 are highest for oil services and services at 4.7% and 4.6%, respectively. Retail trade, manufacturing and construction contacts expect an annual wage growth of 4.3%. For many of the enterprises with the highest wage growth expectations, activity and profitability are strong. Among many occupational categories, strong competition for labour is contributing to higher wage growth expectations in order to both attract and retain labour. At the same time, some contacts expect lower inflation to dampen wage growth in 2025.

On the whole, enterprises report slightly weaker profitability compared with 2023 Q4 (Chart 7). Reduced economic activity and higher costs lead to a deterioration in profitability among construction contacts. Retail trade contacts report difficulties passing on higher costs to selling prices due to strong competition and promotional activity. High demand has contributed to a considerable improvement in margins among oil service contacts. In addition, profitability has improved among manufacturing enterprises, particularly export-oriented enterprises.

Expected annual wage growth. Percent

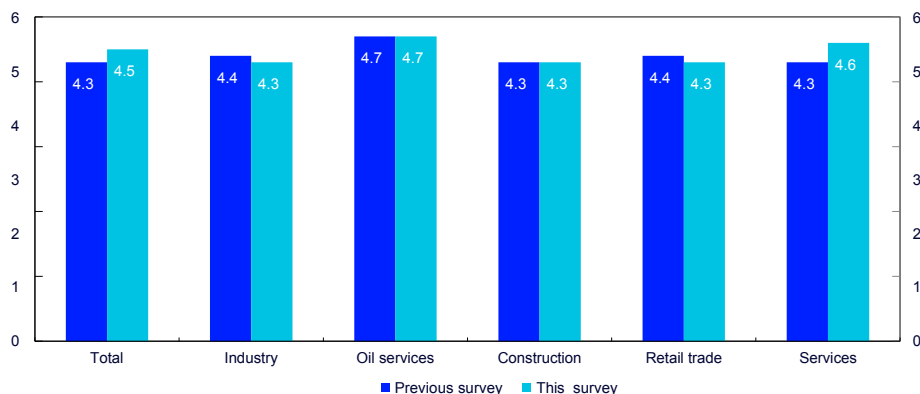
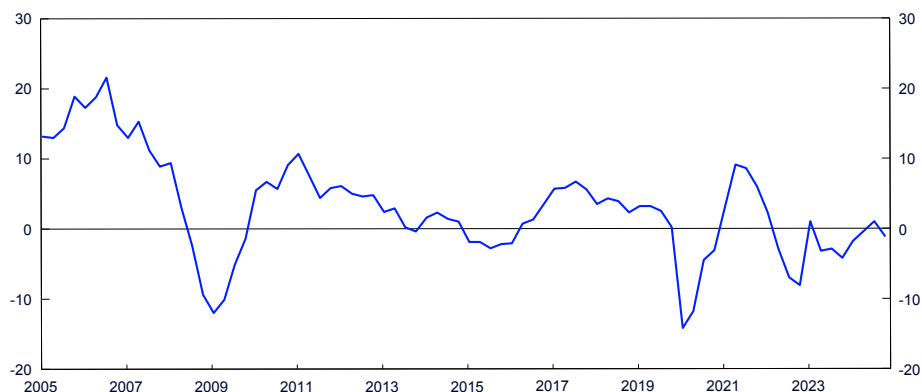


Chart 7 Overall profitability growth

Change in operating margin in the current quarter compared with the same period one year earlier. Percent

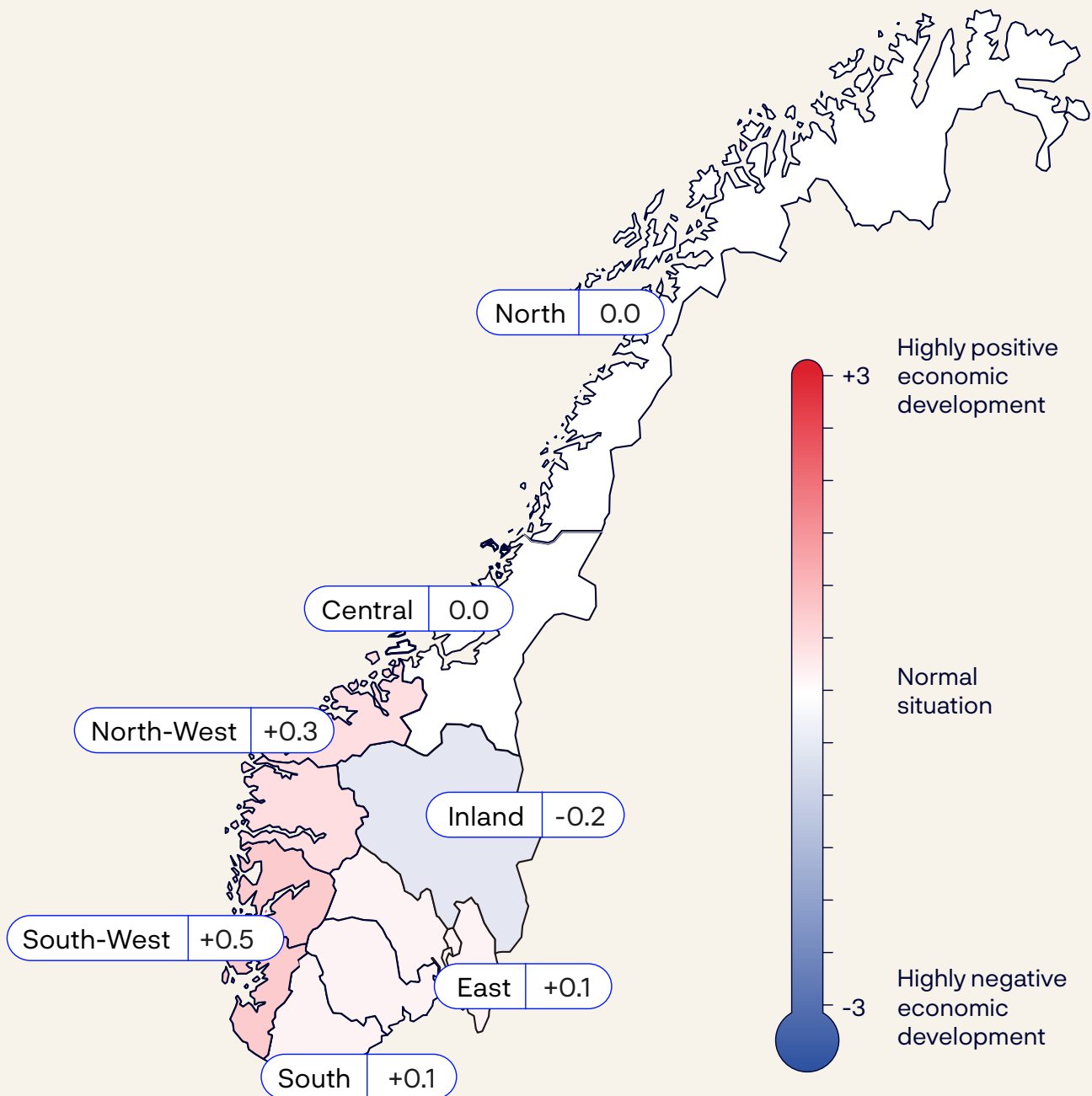


The economic situation is still most robust in western Norway

Contacts are asked, on a scale between -3 and +3, how they would rate the economic situation of their enterprise in terms of demand, profitability and prospects. A value of zero indicates a normal situation. The regional indicator is an average of the responses in the individual region. As in previous surveys, the regional indicator is highest in western regions, where high economic activity in the energy sector is having a strong impact on the economy. In this survey, only the Inland region reports a negative indicator. The weak developments in construction are pushing down regional indicators across the entire country, but most of all in the regions Central, Inland and East.
