

National report



Higher growth, but also heightened uncertainty

Regional Network contacts report a pick-up in growth in 2025 Q1 and expect stable growth in Q2. Increased defence investment and high order levels in maritime industries are lifting growth prospects. In addition, contacts in retail trade and services expect an improvement in households' spending power. The krone exchange rate is strengthening the competitiveness of Norwegian firms, which many contacts expect will boost activity further in the period to summer. Some contacts point out that international trade conflicts are leading to heightened uncertainty, but few expect this to dampen activity in the first half of 2025. Capacity utilisation is slightly higher than in the previous survey, while the share of contacts reporting labour shortages remains unchanged. Contacts estimate annual wage growth of 4.4% in 2025 and 3.9% in 2026.

Contacts expect stable activity growth through the first half of 2025, and growth expectations for Q1 have been revised up slightly from the

Expected growth current quarter and next quarter. Seasonally adjusted. Percent





Chart 2 Output growth. All sectors

previous survey (Charts 1 and 2). Services and retail trade contacts expect the strongest increase, while construction contacts still expect lower activity.

Increased optimism among retail trade contacts

Retail trade contacts expect growth in sales in the period to summer and a large share expect increased household purchasing power to boost sales. Growth expectations are broad-based among contacts, with only a few expecting lower sales. Contacts that sell capital goods such as cars, electrical goods and furniture in particular are driving up expectations compared with the previous survey. A number of contacts believe there is pent-up demand for new capital goods among households as many have deprioritised major purchases in recent years. Contacts also expect that consumer goods sales will continue to increase.

Services contacts expect continued growth in both household and commercial services. In household services, many contacts report an improvement in households' spending power, and contacts expect growth in services such as health and wellness, entertainment and media and communication. Travel industry contacts also expect continued high growth, driven in particular by strong demand from foreign tourists. Many contacts attribute this to the krone exchange rate, with some also pointing to more attractive weather conditions in Norway compared with destinations further south in Europe, which have had little snow in winter and heat waves in summer in recent years.

Commercial services contacts expect further growth in Q1 and Q2. The most pronounced change from previous surveys is that architects expect activity levels to increase in the period to summer. This expectation is supported by technical consultants, who also expect a pick-up in order levels from the construction sector. Employment agencies expect higher activity in the first half of 2025, but a number point out that growth will primarily be in recruitment and to a lesser extent in staffing owing to the

stricter rules since 2023 relating to contract personnel. Contacts in IT expect further growth, in particular driven by demand for help to adopt artificial intelligence. Contacts also expect activity levels to continue to rise in auditing and accounting, and some contacts expect growth in services relating to the purchase and sale of businesses. Many contacts expect higher demand from the Norwegian Armed Forces to boost activity among service contacts.

Contacts expect the decline in construction to slow

Growth expectations are still weakest in construction, and construction contacts expect output to continue to decline in the first half of 2025. At the same time, these contacts expect the decline to slow in the period to summer. They also expect a lower policy rate and report that this is improving prospects. Some construction contacts already report increased new home sales but point out that it will take time for new projects to be launched, and most expect new building activity to increase towards the end of 2025, at the earliest. Contacts expect new commercial building construction to remain subdued, but report increasing order levels related to renovation projects, in particular energy efficiency projects. A large share of contacts report that weak local government finances are pulling down activity. On the other hand, the number of projects funded by the central government has increased, and many contacts report that new defence projects are boosting activity.

High activity in defence and maritime industries

Manufacturing contacts expect output to increase through the first half of 2025, particularly contacts that produce defence materiel and those in maritime industries. Contacts in aquaculture expect that somewhat fewer production problems and favourable ocean temperatures this winter will boost output volumes in the first half of 2025. On the other hand, many contacts point out that deep sea fishing quotas have been reduced for 2025, which limits output and leads to lower activity in some fishing industry segments. Some contacts in the offshore wind industry report high order volumes on the UK continental shelf and emphasise, among other things, favourable subsidy schemes. Building materials manufacturers expect activity to continue to decline in the first half of 2025. A number of manufacturing contacts report higher levels of uncertainty, particularly related to trade barriers, although only a few contacts export directly to US markets. Contacts therefore expect that higher trade barriers for US imports will have a minimal impact on output volumes in the first half of 2025. At the same time, contacts are concerned about the potential consequences of a trade conflict on developments in European markets, which contacts are more exposed to.

Activity among oil services contacts remains high. In the domestic market, the petroleum tax package supports activity in 2025 Q1 and Q2. Higher global demand for oil and gas is pushing up growth in export markets, but capacity constraints are dampening growth among the majority of oil services contacts. Owing to their specialised expertise,

many of the contacts that supply the US petroleum sector expect to be largely unaffected by any trade barriers. At the same time, these contacts highlight the heightened uncertainty surrounding future activity.

Higher investment in 2025


Contacts expect slightly higher investment in 2025 than in 2024, with a further pick-up in 2026. Only a few contacts report that international trade conflicts are substantially dampening the willingness to invest. Investment related to automation and energy transition continues to boost manufacturing investment. In addition, investment in aquaculture is increasing. Contacts expect investment in manufacturing to remain at the same level in 2026. Investment in hotels, restaurants and transport will boost overall investment in services slightly in 2025. On the other hand, investment is being damped by the low number of new CRE projects such as office buildings and shopping centres. However, there are signals in this survey that some CRE projects will be launched in 2026, in addition to building maintenance projects to enhance energy efficiency. Even though capacity expansion by oil service contacts has been substantial in recent years, the level of investment is now expected to fall ahead. Following a period of restraint, there is now pent-up demand for retail shop construction and upgrades. Owing in part to higher sales and profitability, retail trade contacts will lift investment in both 2025 and 2026.

Slightly higher capacity utilisation

The share of contacts reporting full capacity utilisation has increased from 34% in the previous survey to 35% in this survey (Charts 3 and 4), while the share of contacts reporting recruitment difficulties is unchanged. Shortages are most pronounced for engineers and skilled workers, and competition for such expertise across sectors is strong. A number of contacts are able to address the shortages with foreign

Percentage shares



labour, but contacts point out that the krone exchange rate has made Norway less attractive for contract personnel. In the three previous surveys, contacts were asked by how much they could reduce their workforces while maintaining current output levels. On average, contacts in this survey reported that they could reduce staffing by around 3%, which is somewhat less than in the two previous surveys. At the same time, there is an even split between contacts reporting that this share is lower than normal and those reporting it as higher than normal (Chart 5). In the two previous surveys, contacts reporting a higher share outnumbered those reporting a lower share.

Contacts are planning to increase workforces in both 2025 Q1 and Q2. In Q1, services and manufacturing contacts are planning for the strongest growth, but oil services contacts are also planning to increase workforces. Contacts cite higher expected order levels as the primary reason for the increase. Employment agencies and architects have reduced their workforces over a period, although more are planning for growth in this

Share of respondents. Percent





Chart 6 Annual wage growth

survey. Construction workforces will remain unchanged in the period to summer, while growth is expected in other industries.

Contacts expect annual wage growth of 4.4%, down slightly from 4.5% in the previous survey (Chart 6). Contacts in oil services and services have the highest wage growth estimates for 2025, while contacts in construction and retail trade have the lowest. However, the differences between industries are minor. Strong competition for labour in a number of occupational categories is pushing up wage growth expectations. Some contacts point out that the krone exchange rate is contributing to higher wage growth among employees with connections abroad. The wage growth estimate for 2026 is 3.9%.

Stronger profitability

On the whole, profitability among contacts has improved compared with a year ago (Chart 7). For the first time since end-2021, retail trade contacts report improved margins. Together with improved cost control and efficiency gains, higher turnover has boosted profitability among

contacts in retail trade, oil services and services, and some contacts also cite higher prices. For manufacturing contacts, changes in profitability are minor compared with 2024 Q1. The only sector reporting an overall deterioration in profitability is construction.



Clear improvement in the economic situation in the Inland region

Contacts are asked, on a scale between -3 and +3, how they would rate the economic situation of their enterprise in terms of demand, profitability and prospects. A value of zero indicates a normal situation. The regional indicator is an average of the responses in the individual region. In this survey, none of the regions report a negative regional indicator, which is the first time since the series was established at the beginning of 2023. The regional indicator is highest in regions South-West, South and North. In South-West and South, high energy sector demand is among the factors contributing to improving the economic situation of many enterprises. Higher activity levels and increased investment in the aquaculture industry have positive effects on a large share of contacts in region North. Compared with the previous survey, the regional indicator has increased most in region Inland, partly reflecting the positive spillovers from rapid growth in tourism.
